FAQ

Why is one season 8 weeks?

→ In perspective, we meet 1 hour a week. Minimum 8 weeks are needed for the students to build relationship with the teacher and peers.

Can a student request a certain book?

→ Student can always make suggestions and we love to hear what students are interested in. We can not make any promises that we will use the book, but we welcome ideas.

What is the difference between Global and USA Group?

→ USA group is consisted of students born and raised in United states, and Global group is consisted of international students all over the world outside USA.

Do we have to buy the books?

→ Parents are required to supply the books to the student, but not necessarily need to purchase. They may borrow from the library or read an eBook online

Do the students have to read books before class?

→ Yes. Students are required to read the assigned chapters before class. We go over 1 book through 2 weeks.
